



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR CLINICAL DIPLOMA

- A primary dental qualification (such as a Bachelor of Dental Surgery), or its international equivalent
- Curriculum vitae of the applicant
- General Dental Council registration as a dentist
- Proof of right to live and work in the UK (Passport copy or permanent residency card)
- Indemnity to work at Sunrise Dental Clinic
- HBA and HIV test results

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-CLINICAL DIPLOMA

- A primary dental qualification (such as a Bachelor of Dental Surgery), or its international equivalent
- Curriculum vitae of the applicant
- English language requirements: Students whose English is their first language or those who had their primary dental degree taught in English are exempted from English language requirements. Otherwise, you will be expected to demonstrate evidence of an adequate level of English proficiency

EVIDENCE OF ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (FOR NON-CLINICAL DIPLOMA ONLY)

The required evidence may be one of the following:

- Completed a minimum of twelve months' education in a country considered to be 'majority English speaking, including UK, Australia, New Zealand, USA, South Africa
- Completed a minimum of eighteen months of work experience in a country considered to be 'majority English speaking, including UK, Australia, New Zealand, USA, South Africa
- A recently obtained acceptable English language qualification or test result. The qualification or test result must have been awarded no more than two years prior to the proposed date of enrolment.

ACCEPTABLE ENGLISH LANGUAGE QUALIFICATIONS (FOR NON-CLINICAL DIPLOMA ONLY)

- International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Academic Version: Overall grade of 6.5 with a minimum of 6.0 in each of the subtests
- Test of English as Foreign Language (TOEFL) iBT: Standard level: Overall score of 92 with 24/30 in reading and writing and 20/30 in speaking and listening
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English: Standard level: Overall score of 176 with 169 in all subtests
- Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English: Standard level: Overall score of 176 with 169 in all subtests
- City & Guilds (Pitman Examination in International ESOL): Standard level: Pass at Mastery level when achieved with a pass at Mastery level in the Pitman International Spoken test (ISESOL)
- Pearson Test of English (Academic): Standard level: 62 overall, with a minimum of 59 in each Communicative Skill
